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REPORT ON THE WORK OF THE FOUNDATION FOR THE PERIOD FROM APRIL 2022 - MARCH 2023

The Foundation encored to face big challenge due to the covid pandemic for the past three plus years, we're going through a difficult period, lacking funds, no outdoor activities and regular programs urged to be postponed.

With the serving objectives to the community, the Foundation continuous dedicated to make great strides planning for the future – in areas of fund raising and community services to liver health. Though funding and resources continued to be the significant longstop in our operation, the Foundation would never been hinder by any hardship and would strike to intensify our task to serve the community in different dimensions. Especially, the Foundation thanked so much for the tremendous support of our donors and sponsors in this year.

I) PUBLIC EDUCATION ACTIVITIES & SERVICES

1. Liver Donation Campaign

Being a continuous support and contribution in promoting liver health and organ donation organization, the foundation dedicated to raise people's awareness of "liver donation "save life" concept. Our mission is deemed to remind people the crucial issue whenever chances arose. It is concerns for the interest of the end-stage liver patients who are much undergo liver transplant for survival, is one of our core objective.

In July, Hong Kong Society of Transplantation conducted a free media program with 'no commitment' named "移植「心」突破" launched at RTHK31 AM 621 Putonghua Channel for 13 episodes (every Tuesday 21:00 – 22:00). The Society co-act with the Agency for Volunteers Service (義務工作發展局 - AVS) and the Foundation as guests conducted the <u>Episode (4) – 'Liver Transplant & Liver Donation</u>' on air 26/7/2023. Dr. Chok SH, the celebrity, Ms. Jade Kwan (關心妍) and Dr. Chau KF (周嘉歡醫生- mother of one of our liver buddies, Mr Chu Lok Man 朱濼汶) with Dr. Fung (馮加信醫生) were in the dialogue – released general liver health information, aroused liver donation for saving lives, expressing the difficulties for the liver donation and sharing story of liver post-transplant recipient.



2. Hepatitis Vaccination Program

This is one of our routine services for people of Hong Kong who were willing to protect themselves against hepatitis A and hepatitis B infection.

- a/ 3 people participated for Hep A 0 suited for injection & took the service whilst 1 had withdrawn
- b/ 65 people participated for Hep B 59 suited for injection & took the service.

The administer for the injection was conducted by Dr. John Leung LY (one of our Foundation members) started from May 2021 carried out in his clinic – Access Medical Diagnostic & Laboratory & Lee Garden Integrated Diagnosis & Specialist Medical Centre. It was shifted to a private health care company - Supreme Care Limited since March 2023 which was took place at the Foundation office instead.

The injection fees for Hep A & B were :

Hep A – HK\$1,300 (2 doses) Hep B – HK\$850 (3 doses)

3. Production of Health Check Coupons

This is the most welcome benefit to our liver care members. (159 x 2 pcs) health coupons) had been posted out on end June 2022. Numbers of coupons for staff also delivered to the supportive parties – Sun Hing/Mr. KK Yu/Mr. Paul CH/Sunpak Limited the same time. For OCBC was provided through email. The valid date of the said health coupon was from 2 July 2022 to 31 January 2023.

4. Fibro Screening program

The In-house Charged Fibroscan Screening Program of profit-sharing scheme has been extended for one year (from October 2022 to September 2023). The operation was admitted at HKLF office encore and assigned to HKLF staff – Ms. Lilian Leung (Administration Officer) for M & XL probes. XL probe still be provided 'on request' base. The set charged scheduled for the program resumed on 1 October 2022 at HK\$800 for public and HK\$720 offering to our Liver Care members. H&E Committee Chairman - Dr. Lao Wai Cheung was continuously dominated to sign up the referral letters for the above level cases of this program.

*Due to the severe outspread of COVID-19 since mid January 2022, Fibroscan screening service urged to postpone to until September 2022. 6 participants (non-LC members) requested withdrawn the service and had been made the refund in May, June & August 2022 respectively.

5. Community Service Program for Hepatitis B Carriers

This service "Community Service Project for HBV+" had been starting since March 2018 with 1000 quota. The Foundation aimed to serve Hong Kong citizens who had confirmed as a Hepatitis B carrier and had not performed any of liver function tests in the past one year. Participants were offered initially "one free" blood test and doctor consultation (at the first consultation only). HKLF had teamed up 6 volunteer doctors from members of Ad Hoc and H&E Committees to support this program, they were as follow :

In the past year, this service was not actively at all and only 2 participants (1 Female & 1 Male aged 30-39) were attended in the period of 1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023.

207 participants in total had participated this "Free" service since the program had been establishing in 2018



6. Meeting with Liver Specialists Patient Gathering Sessions

Due to the outspread of COVID-19 in 2022-2023, this activity had suspended for this period of year.

7. Health Talk

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the un-forecasted condition, for safety reason to the public, the Foundation had to postpone this crowded activity until further notice.

II) PATIENT SUPPORT GROUPS ACTIVITIES

1. Liver Buddies patient support group

- a) Simon K Y Lee Memorial Scholarship The 12nd Scholarship 2021-2022 received no application for this year.
- b) Christmas Party 2022

It had been suspended encore for this year recommended by QM hospital and the Council due to the outspread of COVID-19, the booked venue at QM Hospital had been called off. Nevertheless, LF has reserved the same venue for next year's Christmas party 2023 which would be held on 16th December 2023 (Saturday).

2. Liver Care patient support group

The Foundation offered annual health check program for eligible group members who submitted annual subscription fee of HK\$50.00. It was one of the most welcome advantages for the group. The membership renewal reminder for 2023 was sent on end December 2022 and 125 Liver Care members had been renewed their membership until end March 2023 including 11 new members joined in between April 2022 to end March 2023.
